FACTS

How many years does it take to get an interior design degree?

It takes 4 years to achieve a Bachelors in Interior Design.

How many States have passed legislation in Interior Design?

Twenty-two states have passed legislations. Indiana passed a voluntary registry in 2009.

What are the requirements to register as an interior designer in Indiana?

To register as an interior designer in Indiana, one must pass the NCIDQ. Being a registered interior designer informs the public of those designers who have met the criteria to attain registration. It does not impede employment of non-registered designers and is self-sustaining.

How many registered Interior Designers practice in Indiana?

There are 351 R.I.D.S (Registered Interior Designers) in Indiana.

House Bill, HEA 1573 became effective July 1, 2009, allowing interior designers to voluntarily register with the State of Indiana through the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency (IPLA). It allows Registered Interior Designers to set themselves apart and allows consumers and employers a way to vet candidates in this field. Our registry is self-monitoring; the Interior Design Coalition of Indiana (IDCI) supports the renewal process, sending notifications to registered designers of approaching expiration dates and continuing education reminders.
